THE ASYLUM CENTRE IN KRNJACA, BELGRADE, SERBIA
(REFUGEES CAMP)



SUWAIBAH NASIR VISITED THE ASYLUM CENTRE IN KRNJACA

Ms. Suwaibah Nasir, after the successful completion of the Avala Tower Run and in her efforts to promote humanitarian work and its role in handling the migrant crisis, visited the Krnjaca Asylum Center (AC) in Belgrade on 2 September 2016.

During her 2-hour long tour of the camp provided by the hospitable staff of the Asylum Center operating under the Commissariat for Refugees and Migration of the Government of the Republic of Serbia, Ms. Suwaibah Nasir was informed that the total of 750 000 migrants freely travelled across Serbia on their road to the EU over the past two years without incidents.

The AC in Belgrade is one of ten such centers in Serbia and houses 820 migrants coming from Syria, Iran, Iraq and Afghanistan, but also from the North African countries such as Sudan and Ghana. Out of those 820 migrants living in 16 barracks of the AC, 565 expressed wish to stay in Serbia and join more than 4500 migrants who were already granted asylum in Serbia.

Management of AC in Belgrade was particularly proud to inform that 257 migrants who refused to seek asylum in Serbia and therefore are staying illegally, were not denied AC's hospitality. In the Belgrade AC, migrants are provided with accommodation in solidly build barracks, freedom to go in or out of AC, 3 meals per day provided by the Serbian Government and a lunch box provided by the Red Cross, free Wi-Fi internet connection everywhere in AC and a small computer room with internet access, free laundry service with volunteers and legal aid provided by the lawyers' NGOs such as the Asylum Protection Centre (APC).

The facilities, on the other hand, need restoration as the barrack are 30 years old. Renovation of three out of 16 barracks has been completed already and three more is underway, all financed by the foundation of Vlade Divac, former NBA basketball star and the current President of the Olympic Committee of Serbia. Ten more barracks are in need of urgent renovation and 6 more need to be built to house additional 500-600 hundred of migrants currently living in the streets of downtown Belgrade, especially in view of the upcoming cold Serbian winter.

With Hungary letting only 30 migrants to enter the country daily, the number of migrants in Serbia is expected to continue to increase at a high pace. According to the AC representatives, EUR 25 000 (RM 100 000) is the price of the construction works per barrack, which is challenging to collect in the short period of time, immediate action is required.

During her direct interaction with the migrants, Ms. Suwaibah was deeply moved by the stories of their long journeys through Greece, Turkey and the Middle East countries, split families and high number of teenagers travelling without their parents.

By visiting the Asylum Centre in Belgrade, Ms. Suwaibah Nasir concluded her visit to Serbia. In pursue of her "One Woman's Mission to Conquer 30 of the World's Tallest Towers" Humanitarian Tour, she will depart for New York, where she will make her second attempt at the Empire State Building.
